Community Service Project



The ASID MS District partnered with the Mississippi College ASID student chapter on a community service project. The Magnolia Speech School was selected as the site of the project. Magnolia Speech School is a non-public, special purpose, non-profit school, accredited by both the Mississippi State Department of Education (K to 8th grade) and by AdvancED. Magnolia Speech School offers audiological services for pre-school and elementary-age children including behavioral management, language stimulation and sensory integration.
